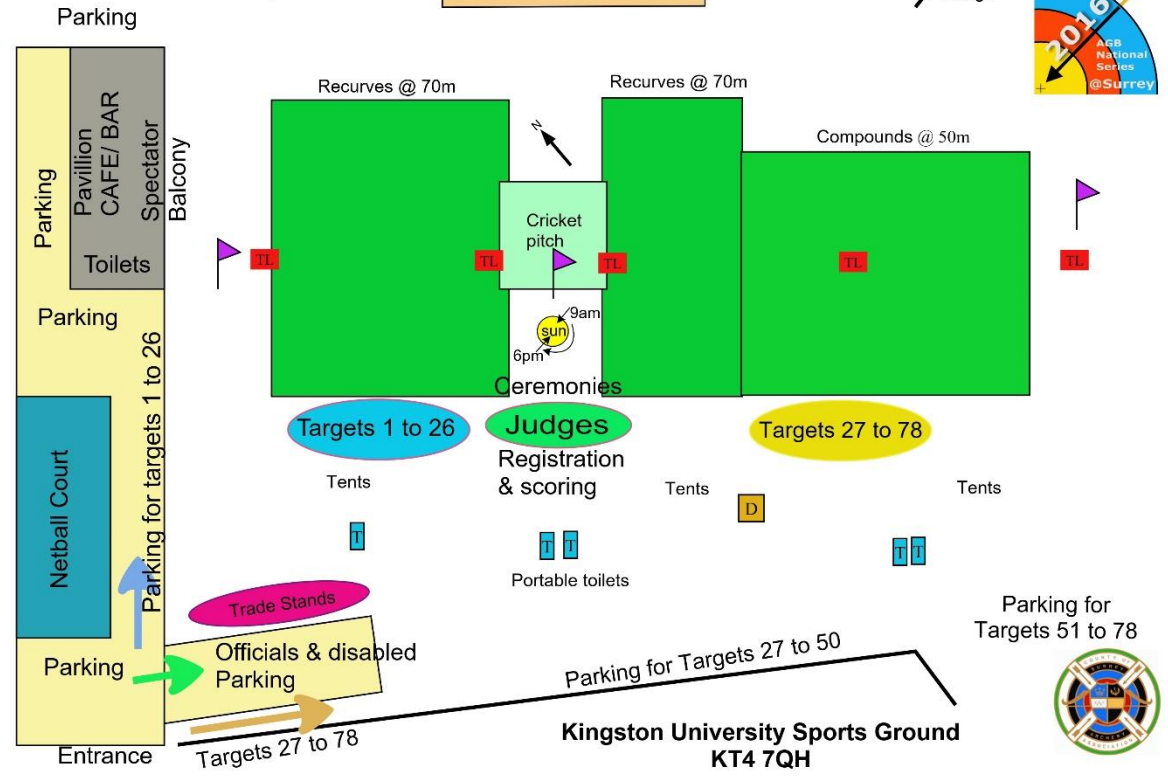
Location of Surrey Archery Weekend
